

What to bring for your appointment

- Current Photo ID must be shown to the collector for the collection to proceed.
- Your written statement or commercial pathology request form requesting the AS4308 urine drug screening test.

Fees

This test incurs a fee. You must either:

- Provide SA Pathology with a written statement (on letterhead) or a commercial pathology request form from the third party clearly stating they will accept the costs.

OR

- You will need to sign an agreement to pay form for the cost of the test.

What to Expect

- The test will take approximately 30 minutes.
- You will be asked if you are currently taking any medications/substances and other personal information.
- After you have provided your urine sample, you will need to remain with the collector until the last sample is sealed in a tamper evident bag. Please be patient and wait until the collector instructs you to leave.

Sample Collection - General Steps

- The collector will ask you to remove coats/jumpers and to empty your pockets.
- You will be asked to wash your hands without soap prior to producing a sample.
- A coloured solution will be added to the toilet. Water sources will be sealed so they can't be used; and soap and any other items in the cubicle will be removed or sealed as well.
- A sample collection cup will be provided for you to submit a minimum 30mL of urine.
- The collection staff member waits outside the cubicle door whilst you urinate.
- Once finished, the sample cup is handed to the collector. The collector observes the toilet prior to flushing.
- The urine sample will undergo two integrity checks. If the checks are outside the normal range, or anything unusual is noted of the urine, another sample will be required.
- You will need to sign all tamper evident labels, seals and forms.
- Please follow collectors' instructions on where to sign.
